Edinburgh 125 miles; Glasgow 140 miles; Inverness 30 miles; Perth 80 miles; Stirling 115 miles

By Car: Turn right at the more northern junction at Aviemore on the main A9 trunk road, between Perth and Inverness.

By Train: Aviemore Station (15 miles) and Carrbridge Station (10 miles) are served by direct main line trains from Inverness, Edinburgh, Glasgow and the South.

By Air: Inverness Airport, with regular direct daily flights from international hubs - eg London, Dublin, Manchester and Amsterdam - is some 32 miles from Grantown-on-Spey. Edinburgh, Glasgow and Aberdeen airports are a pleasant two to four hour drive through stunning countryside.

Car Hire: Available in Aviemore and Inverness.
