MONTERIO VIURA (SPAIN) ^{WHITE} £18.50

A dry white wine with a clean, delicate taste of citrus fruits.

Served by the glass.

MONTERIO ROSADO (SPAIN) ^{RED} £18.50

Aroma's of fresh strawberries. Dry on the palate with good acidity on the finish.

Lots of bright red cherry flavour, with smooth tannins and good acidity on the finish.

MASCHIO PROSECCO SPUMANTE ^{20CL} £7.95

Light straw yellow in colour with a lively froth. Bouquet of white peach and orange blossoms. Fruit forward, with peach and almond flavours.

MASCHIO PROSECCO SPUMANTE ^{75CL} £25.50

Light straw yellow in colour with a lively froth. Bouquet of white peach and orange blossoms. Fruit forward, with peach and almond flavours.

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ORGANIC WINE

DON JACOBO RIOJA CRIANZA ORGANIC (SPAIN) £25.00

Red ruby colour with medium intensity; red and black fruit, dairy and vanilla on the nose; in the mouth has soft tannins and good acidity, fruity and slightly spiced, hints of new oak barrel and a lingering finish.

FIANO ZENSA ORGANIC PUGLIA (ITALY) £28.50

The wine is straw yellow in color and displays delicate aromas of lemon-lime, peach, almonds and honeysuckle. The palate is crisp and refreshing, with an elegant, mouth-watering balance of fruit and acidity.

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ROSE

PECKING ORDER PINOTAGE ROSE, (SOUTH AFRICA) £19.00

With notes of strawberries and raspberries. A very easy drinking wine, with subtle red fruits and a soft finish.

CONTE VECCHIO PINOT GRIGIO BLUSH (ITALY) £19.50

This Pinot Grigio is pleasant on the nose with lemon, pear and slightly floral notes. On the palate, it is crisp and balanced.

THE BULLETIN ZINFANDEL ROSE £20.00

This semi-sweet wine has plenty of raspberry and watermelon fruit flavours. Juicy and light, it has a refreshing finish.

CÔTES DE PROVENCE ROUMERY ROSÉ, CHATEAU DES FERRAGES £32.00

Château des Ferrages is located in Pourcieux, between Aix-en-Provence and Saint-Maximin in the lowland of Sainte-Victoire. The estate covers 28 hectares and produces both Côtes-de-Provence and Côtes-de-Provence Saint-Victoire wines. The estate produces around 200,000 bottles, with 90% dedicated to rosé. Translucent, very pale pink colour with almost water like hue. Dry and possessing good textural qualities on the the palate which has flavours of cherries and raspberries followed by some ripe strawberries and spice.

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

PALMER & CO BRUT RESERVE NV CHAMPAGNE £49.00

Rich, aromatic palate of white fruits, pears, baked apples and apricots, with subtle notes of honey, hazelnuts, dried currants and brioche. The finish is long, harmonious and structured, with a beautiful freshness.

PALMER & CO BRUT RESERVE ROSE NV CHAMPAGNE £55.00

Intense aromas of wild strawberries with notes of blackcurrants and redcurrants, and delicate spicy notes of vanilla and cinnamon. The mousse is intense, creamy and persistent. The palate is fresh and delicate with fine bubbles.

TAITTINGER BRUT RESERVE NV £65.00

It is dry, light and graceful with small, fine bubbles. Fresh citrus fruit and subtle, weightier notes of peach and brioche combine to provide elegance in a glass.

MOËT ET CHANDON BRUT NV £65.00

Moët Impérial is the House's iconic champagne. Created in 1869, it embodies their unique style, distinguished by its bright fruitiness, seductive palate and elegant maturity. Bouquet of vibrant apple and citrus fruit, mineral nuances, white flowers, brioche and nuts.

WHITE WINE

PECKING ORDER CHENIN BLANC (SOUTH AFRICA) £21.00

A distinctive dry but fruit-driven style with fresh citrus fruit on the nose and a smooth, well-balanced palate.

VENDEMIÀ PINOT GRIGIO (ITALY) £19.00

Light and fresh with hints of nectarine, almond and white flowers.

MOONDARRA CHARDONNAY (AUSTRALIA) £21.00

Delicious flavours of peach and pineapple, with bright acidity on the finish.

PICPOUL DE PINET MAS PUECH (FRANCE) £26.00

Delicate aromas of citrus fruits and a delightful grapefruit bitterness. Mouth-watering freshness combined with stone fruit and citrus on the palate.

WAIPARA HILLS SAUVIGNON BLANC (MARLBOROUGH NZ) £27.50

Made from 100% Sauvignon Blanc sourced from vineyards in both the Wairau and Awatere valleys of the Marlborough region. Settled juice is fermented with a range of yeasts at cool temperatures for about three weeks; a period of resting off the lees is followed by bottling. A generous and lifted style, showing powerful aromas of melon, nettle and snow pea; the palate bursts with fresh citrus, grapefruit and melon notes, the fruit carrying through to the aromatic finish.

A20 ALBARINO 21 BODEGAS CASTRO MARTIN £31.00

Aromatic wine with great acidity and minerality, just a delight.

TUFFOLO GAVI DI GAVI (ITALY) £32.00

One of the best Italian grape varieties, minerally, flinty and with great acidity.

SANCERRE CHEZATTE (FRANCE) £39.00

This wine is bright and refreshing, with aromas and flavours of lemon, lime and apple, with a subtle mineral note and a mouth-watering finish.

CHABLIS LA CHABLISIENNE LA FINAGE BURGUNDY (FRANCE) £37.00

This wine has aromas of white fruit and citrus, with hints of minerality. It is well-balanced with fresh acidity on the finish.

RED WINE

MOONDARRA SHIRAZ (AUSTRALIA) £20.00

A rich, spicy mouthful of ripe plums and bramble fruits. Soft, rich and warm in style and finish.

RARE VINEYARDS PINOT NOIR (FRANCE) £22.00

The Pinot Noir grapes come from vineyards located in the south-west of Languedoc Roussillon, close to the Pyrénées Mountains; The smooth, velvety palate shows cherry and blueberry flavours backed with a hint of sweet oak spice.

ARGENTO MALBEC (ARGENTINA) £27.50

This medium-bodied red wine has aromas and flavours of plums, black cherries and hints of violet. It has a velvety smooth texture and a soft lingering finish.

CHIANTI RUFFINO (ITALY) £28.00

When Chianti became a DOCG in 1984, it was a bottle of Ruffino Chianti that wore the first warranty strip bearing the number 00000001. Even though this might not have been an intentional gesture, it seems to render a secret tribute, giving Ruffino and its Chianti 'first-born' status in the appellation. This was the first wine produced by the founders Ilario and Leopoldo, and is a wine that has written many pages in Italian wine history. Made exclusively of Sangiovese, it shows floral and fruity notes that lead towards spicy scents of white pepper and hazelnuts.

RIOJA GRAN RESERVA CASTILLO (CLAVIJO) £32.00

Complex and full bodied, with rich red and black berry fruit aromas, figs and prunes, complemented with vanilla, smoke and cedar from oak ageing. Smooth and elegant with some mushroom, leather and forest floor notes on the finish.

WAIPARA HILLS PINOT NOIR (CENTRAL OTAGO NZ) £34.95

Bramble fruit, cherry, spice and a hint of smoke on the nose; black cherry and plum on the palate supported by vanilla spice.

CHATEAU GARDEGAN BORDEAUX SUPERIEUR (FRANCE) £32.00

A beautiful classic Bordeaux. A nice aromatic cuvée, powerful and complex with spicy notes, black currant, pepper, menthol and clove, a solid structure, body and density. A wine that gets better with age.

CHATEAU ST COSME "LES DEUX ALBIONS" COTE DU RHONE £37.00

This wine is brimming with fruit and fleshiness with a real liquorice streak. Flavours of overripe strawberry, gingerbread, honey and bacon. Bottled without filtering.

AMARONE DELLA VALPOLICELLA (ITALY) £45.00

A great example of Amarone; distinctive and complex on the nose with hints of cherry conserve, vanilla, balsamic, floral and ripe fruit notes. The palate is dry, warm and concentrated with an elegant, spicy finish. Particularly robust and rich.
